

## USING THE LIBRARY

*A wonderful world of books is awaiting you in the Children's Library! The call number on the spine of each book helps you find what you want.*



## FICTION

Most fiction books are arranged by the author's last name. In some cases, books might be arranged by the series name. Picture books are located around the trees and have EASY call numbers; chapter books are in the taller stacks just beyond the trees and have J call numbers. Here are some examples:

## AUDIO-VISUAL

DVDs, VHS, CDs, and Audiobooks are all located in the AV area under the windows. DVDs and VHS are arranged alphabetically by title. Audiobooks and CDs are arranged by author/artist.

## NONFICTION

Nonfiction books are arranged by the Dewey Decimal System. These books will have a J or EASY before the number to specify that they belong in the Children's Library. Both EASY and J nonfiction can be found in the taller stacks.
